In 2024, the Korea Anti-Doping Agency made efforts to reduce blind spots in athletes' doping management through doping tests, education, research, and more.

First, we enhanced pre-doping management to prevent violations of anti-doping rules for national athletes at the Paris Olympics and Paralympic Games. We conducted pre-doping education and doping tests for 144 Olympic athletes and 84 Paralympic athletes, which helped raise awareness of anti-doping among national athletes.

Second, we intensified anti-doping education for student athletes. We implemented experiential anti-doping education and sports mentoring tailored to the needs of student athletes to enhance the effectiveness of our educational initiatives. Additionally, we provided anti-doping education for parents and teachers through collaboration with regional education offices in Seoul, Busan, and Gangwon-do to strengthen our support for student athletes. We will continue to work with more regional education offices to foster a safe environment for student athletes against doping.

Third, we updated the information on prohibited substances in herbal medicines through a study on herbal medicine ingredients for the first time in 11 years. By analyzing the ingredients of 32 herbal medicines frequently taken by athletes, we detected prohibited substances in 15 of them. In particular, we were able to identify 'higenamine,' a prohibited substance found in herbal medicines commonly prescribed in traditional medicine clinics, which had not been identified before.

I want to thank everyone who helped the Korea Anti-Doping Agency grow over the past year, and I ask for your continued interest and support in the future.







Number of Cases of Detecting Prohibited Substances






